# Summary of support for mine action: 2009-2013



- > \$3.225b contributed since 2009
- > Affected states provided nearly \$900m since 2009
- > International support totaled \$2.327b since 2009
- > 3 donors contributed 50% of all mine action funding, with \$1.113b
- > 7 donors have contributed more than \$100m each: Australia, European Union, Germany, Japan, the Netherlands, Norway, & the US
- > Support from States Parties has accounted for 61% of all funding in 2009-2013

## Focus on Sub-Saharan Africa

- > 19 donors contributed \$76.5m to 17 Sub-Saharan African states & 1 other area in 2013
- > Japan, Norway, & the US contributed \$33.5m, approx. 44% of all support to Sub-Saharan Africa
- > Sub-Saharan Africa received 18% of international assistance worldwide, the third highest total for a region
